Its cascading brass arms and delicately diffused light from black metal shades—outlined in a thin red accent—create an atmosphere of whispered intimacy. Ideal for spaces with high ceilings, it evokes a sense of theatrical rhythm and timeless grace. The brushed brass reflects light with warmth, while the dark lampshades filter it into a soft, poetic glow—never invasive, always enveloping.

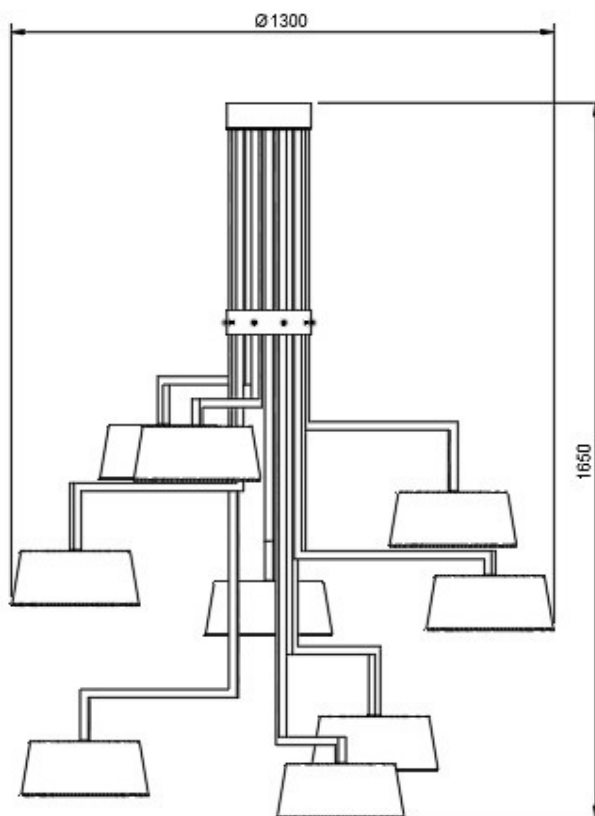

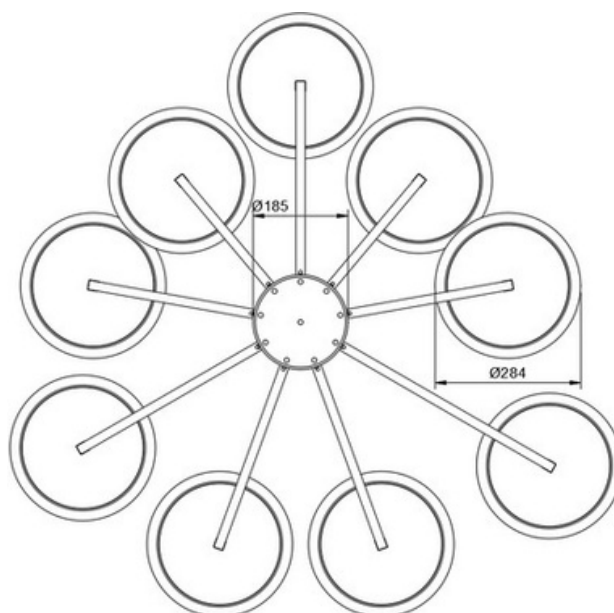
